## ClubsNSW Busking Competition 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> January 2011 **Busking Competition Registration Form**

### General Terms and Conditions

Completed entry forms must be returned by December 18<sup>th</sup> 2010.

There will be 3 categories in the competition - Adult, Youth and Junior.

Prizes: First prize - Adult \$850 Youth \$350 Junior \$250

Runner up - Adult \$350 Youth \$150 Junior \$100

Prizes will be paid after announcement of winners on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> January.

Prizes are awarded per entry, not per person.

To enter, buskers must perform Elvis music or music of the Elvis era. As this is an Elvis Busking Competition, to qualify for the prizes Elvis songs must be performed.

Buskers will be assigned a site. Organisers will endeavour to fulfil your requests on site location but this cannot be guaranteed. Buskers must not move site unless permission is granted from organisers.

Organisers reserve the right to remove buskers who are acting inappropriately.

Proof of age identification may be required.

Only Official registered buskers may enter the competition.

Official busking identification will be provided to registered buskers along with site information and schedule. Official identification must be displayed at all times.

Power will be supplied, but entrants must provide their own sound equipment.

ClubsNSW as Naming Rights sponsor may ask you to display ClubsNSW promotional material at your site.

### Adult Competition (Ages 18 +)

Buskers must perform for a minimum of 2 days (min. 4 hours per day) to qualify for the competition.

Judging for finalist position (3 finalist positions available) will be based on a popular choice system. Only official voting slips will be counted. Voting slips will be issued and collected at the Cooke Park and Clarinda Street Information Booths.

Busking finalists will need to be available to perform on the Main Stage on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> January where judges will decide the final winners.

### Youth and Junior Competition

Buskers must perform for a minimum of 2 days (min. of 2 hours per day) to qualify for the competition.

Junior competition is open to entrants 12 years and under. Youth competition is open to entrants aged 13 - 17.

Judging will be by popular choice only. Junior and Youth entrants will not be required to perform on the Main Stage.
